- Veritas Preparatory Charter School occasionally releases information to third parties such as student name, DOB, neighborhood of residence, participation in officially recognized activities/athletic teams, degrees, honors, and rewards, and post high-school plans.
- Veritas Preparatory Charter School receives bus transportation from Springfield Public Schools; if a 5th grade scholar lives over 1.5 miles from home to school they will receive transportation, if a 6th-8th scholar lives 2.0 miles and over from home to school they will receive transportation.
